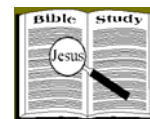

**YEAR FOR PRIESTS 2009 ~ JUNE 19 ~ 2010**  
 A prayer by a Dominican priest who lived in the 19th century, a man named Fr. Henri Dominique Lacordaire, wrote this prayer about what it means to be a priest, and this is what it says: *"To live in the midst of the world without wishing its pleasures; to be a member of each family, yet belong to none; to share all sufferings; to penetrate all secrets; to heal all wounds; to go from men to God and offer Him their prayers; to return from God to men to bring pardon and hope; to have a heart of fire for charity and a heart of bronze for chastity. To teach; and to pardon; to console and bless always. My God, what a life! And it is yours, O priest of Jesus Christ! Amen."*

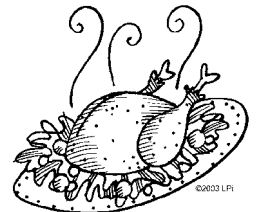
