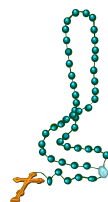

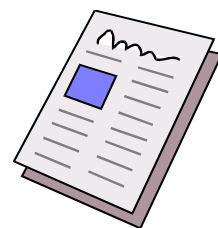


Let us all pray for peace. Please keep our service women and men in your prayers.
