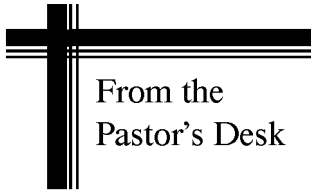

**From the
Pastor's Desk**

The time of prayer and waiting is completed and the disciples now receive the Holy Spirit that will allow them to fulfill their mission. The reversal of Babel now takes place. The "strong driving wind" language also says that they, the disciples, will not be able to stay put. The Spirit of God will move them on. The "tongues as of fire" language is a reminder of the language of the Easter Exsultet. "A flame divided yet undimmed." The distribution of the power and gifts of the Holy Spirit does not diminish the Spirit. "To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit." The rest of this reading gives the purpose and the aim of the gifts given by the Holy

Spirit. It is for the "benefit" of the whole body, not just for the one to whom it has been given.

Jesus also says to his Apostles: "Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, whose sins you retain are retained." The connection seems to be that since they have received the Holy Spirit that they have the power to forgive sins. Amazingly, there seems to be another distinction to this in that those who do not forgive, but do not have the authority not to forgive – it is not through the authority of the Holy Spirit that forgiveness is withheld – would themselves have forgiveness withheld from them. Something for us, as members of the one body of Christ, to remember when we are called to forgive someone who sins against us?

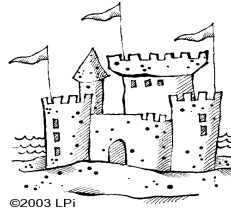

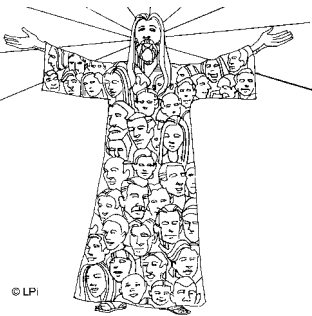
Reflection of the Week
